



Terms and Conditions – ‘Night at the Museum’ Sleepover Experience

The ‘Night at the Museum’ experience is an afterhours family event for up to 32 people. To ensure that everyone has an enjoyable and memorable experience, we ask guests to assist with the following:

- The South Australian Museum is located on North Terrace, in the Adelaide CBD. Overnight car parking is available at the Museum for all event attendees. Please secure any valuables inside your vehicle, out of sight as you will have limited opportunity to check on your vehicle during the experience.
- If you are running late, please call the Membership Team on 0438 117 500 to advise.
- Your ‘Night at the Museum’ sleepover experience will commence at 5pm at the South Australian Museum; your event hosts will meet and escort you to your sleeping area. The ‘Night at the Museum’ experience will conclude at 9am the following day; you can spend the rest of the day in the Museum if you wish. *Note: there will be additional Member activities planned on the Sunday morning during the opening weekend of the Dinosaur rEvolution exhibition between 9 – 10am which Members are welcome to attend.*
- We ask that mobile phones be placed on “vibrate” or silent mode to maximise your Museum experience.
- All children must be a minimum of eight (8) years to attend for OH&S and insurance purposes. Children must be accompanied by a supervising parent or adult at all times, with no more than three (3) children attending for each supervising adult.
- Running and excessive yelling is not advised during the experience to ensure everyone has a great time.
- Children are not permitted to play on stairways or elevators – there will be many activities planned during your experience to entertain young guests.
- Younger or older siblings can join in on all the fun of the ‘Night at the Museum’ experience, if they are between the suggested age range, but must be included in the booking to ensure we have enough personalised campsites for all attendees. The program is especially created for children between 8 – 14 years of age.
- Your child can go to bed early if they are tired after a full evening of activities. Parental or adult supervision is required once your child leaves the communal activity area, as you never know what comes alive in the Museum at night! Please let staff know if any of your party needs to leave the Museum early so that staff can assist where possible.
- The experience is a camp style experience with no power available to each individual teepee. Please let the staff know if you have any items that require a power source during your visit.
- Your hosts have an exciting menu planned throughout your visit so there should be no need to bring any additional food/drink with you unless you have specific dietary requirements that we cannot cater for. All attempts will be made to ensure all catering requirements are met. If you are likely to need extra snacks during your experience, then you are welcome to pack these, but please advise the team on arrival. Please refrain from bringing any alcohol with you as this is a family friendly experience.
- Respect your fellow overnighter and their belongings to ensure an exciting time is had by all.
- All Museum Team hosts hold a current Police Clearance; Wilson Security remain onsite throughout the duration of the event.
