

South Australian Museum X CABN Competition Australian Geographic Nature Photographer of the Year 2019

Terms and Conditions

- 1.** The Promoter is South Australian Museum (ABN: 39 808 959 302) of GPO Box 234 Adelaide 5001 / North Terrace, Adelaide SA 5000 and the competition Partner is CABN of 11 Jasper Street Hyde Park Adelaide SA 5000.
 - 2.** Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
 - 3.** Entry is open to all residents of South Australia. However, employees and their immediate families of South Australian Museum, Australian Geographic, Coral Expeditions, Atkins, The Adelaide Review and any other benefiting parties, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
 - 4.** The competition commences on **Friday 16 August 2019 at 10:00 (ACST)** and concludes on **Sunday 20 October 2019 at 17:00 (ACST)**.
 - 5.** The competition will be advertised at the South Australian Museum and across the following:
 - The South Australian Museum's social media channels and website
 - CABN social media channels
 - 6.** To enter, participants must:
 - a)** Purchase a ticket to Australian Geographic Nature Photographer of the Year 2019 exhibition via www.samuseum.sa.gov.au;Or
 - b)** Purchase a ticket in person at the exhibition;And
 - c)** Complete the People's Choice voting form in the exhibition space, registering contact details including (but not limited to) name, address, phone number and e-mail address.*
- * Australian Geographic Nature Photographer of the Year 2019 People's Choice voting will be held at the South Australian Museum during the period of 16 August 2019 and 20 October 2019 only.*
- 7.** Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the prior permission of a parent or guardian over the age of 18 to enter.
 - 8.** Illegible, incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
 - 9.** Only one vote per person will be valid.
 - 10.** The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity and proof of residency at the nominated prize delivery address in order to claim a prize. Proof of identification and residency considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.
 - 11.** The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of Promoter, includes objectionable content, profanity, and potentially insulting, inflammatory or defamatory statements.
 - 12.** The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process, who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions of Entry or who has, in the opinion of the Promoter, engaged in conduct in entering the Promotion which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Promotion and/or Promoter. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify a winner if the Promoter becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.
 - 13.** Entries in the form of People's Choice voting forms submitted on site at the South Australian Museum must be received by 17:00 (ACST) on Sunday 20 October 2019. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries.
 - 14.** Any entry that is made on behalf of an Entrant by a third party will be invalid.
 - 15.** The Major Prize Winner will receive:
 - I.** Provision of a \$500 voucher for redemption against two nights' accommodation at any of CABN's South Australian-based cabins.
 - II.** The voucher can only be redeemed for accommodation (two night stay) and not for any optional extras such as food packs.
 - III.** The Major Prize Winner must redeem the accommodation voucher directly with CABN.
 - 16.** Total prize value is \$500 (including GST).

- 17.** The CABN voucher will be valid for 12 months from date of issue. Vouchers are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged for cash. No change will be given. The voucher can be redeemed in whole or for part of a payment. CABN are not responsible if a voucher is lost, altered, damaged, destroyed or stolen, or used without permission. Weekends are very popular and CABN cannot guarantee availability, so recommend the winner considers a mid-week escape option and checks availability online as soon as possible.
- 18.** If the winner is under the age of 18 as at the date of the draw, an adult must accompany the minor in the participation of the prize.
- 19.** Unless expressly stated in these terms and conditions all other expenses become the responsibility of the winner.
- 20.** If the prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or greater value, subject to State Regulation.
- 21.** Once prizes have left the Promoter's premises, the Promoter takes no responsibility for prizes damaged, delayed or lost in transit.
- 22.** In the event that for any reason whatsoever a winner does not take the prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize.
- 23.** If the competition winner is under 18 years of age, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian on behalf of the winner.
- 24.** Each valid entrant who has entered the competition over the duration of the promotional period will be entered into the draw. One (1) valid entrant will be drawn at random to become the Major Prize Winner. - 25.** If any particular draw is scheduled on a public holiday, the draw will be conducted on the following business day.
- 26.** The winners will be notified within two business days of the draw. The winner will be notified of their prize in writing.
- 27.** Prizes will be awarded to person named in the entry.
- 28.** Should an entrant's contact details change during the promotional period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter. A request to access or modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to Promoter.
- 29.** The Promoter's decision is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the Competition result.
- 30.** It is a condition of accepting the prize that the winner must comply with all the conditions of use of the prize and the prize supplier's requirements.

- 33.** The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
